The **Directorate-General for Employment and Social Affairs of the European Commission,** has entrusted a consortium of contractors, led by Kantar Belgium together with Rand Europe and Visionary Analytics, to carry out a feasibility study for the development of a (self-) assessment tool focused on skills management practices in Small and Medium size enterprises.
